Starting February 1, we will begin replacing the main elevator that provides access to all floors of the mausoleum. This upgrade is part of our commitment to preserving this historic landmark while enhancing accessibility and safety for everyone who visits.

Why This Project Is Necessary

Wilhelm's Mausoleum has been a cherished part of the Portland community for generations. As caretakers of this special place, we are dedicated to ensuring it remains safe, accessible, and welcoming for families and visitors. This new elevator will improve reliability and provide better access for years to come.

What This Means for You

During this time, the elevator will be out of service for approximately 4-6 months.

As a result:

- Only the 5th floor will be wheelchair accessible during this period.
- Access to all floors will remain available via alternative methods, but they may not accommodate all mobility needs.
