If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff

This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials and forwarding or receiving remains). This fee includes the following:

- Personnel available 24 hours a day, 365 days a year to respond to initial call.
- Sheltering remains.
- Arrangement conference.
- Coordinating service plans with cemetery, crematory, and/or other parties involved in the final disposition of the deceased.
- Clerical assistance in the completion of various forms associated with a funeral.
- Securing and recording the death certificate and disposition permit.
- Also covers overhead, such as facility maintenance, equipment and inventory costs, insurance and administration expense, and government compliance.

Embalming

Additional Care of Autopsied Remains (Embalmed/Unembalmed)

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

Dressing and Casketing

Forwarding of Remains to Another Funeral Home

This charge includes removal of deceased, necessary services of staff, embalming, and necessary authorizations. This charge does not include visitation, rites, or ceremonies prior to forwarding of deceased. Does not include transportation to airport.

Receiving of Remains From Another Funeral Home

This charge includes basic services of funeral director and staff, shelter of remains, transportation of deceased to cemetery, and staff & equipment for a graveside service. This charge does not include visitation or transportation to airport.

Immediate Burials

Our charge for an immediate burial includes local removal from place of death, basic services of staff, authorizations & casket coach to local cemetery. It does not include embalming, ceremonies, visitations, or refrigeration. The time and date of burial will be at the discretion of the funeral director.

Direct Cremation

Our charges for a direct cremation (without visitation, rites, or ceremonies) include removal of remains, local transportation to crematory, minimum services of staff, and cremation fee. If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The minimum container we offer is made of corrugated fiberboard.
