TRADITIONAL SERVICE PACKAGES

The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

TRADITIONAL CHAPEL OR CHURCH FUNERAL* **\$4,690**

This package includes our basic services and overhead, embalming, dressing, placement in casket, facilities and staff for visitation, facilities, equipment and staff for funeral service, transfer of remains from place of death, traditional hearse (casket, outer burial container, and cemetery charges not included)

TRADITIONAL CHAPEL FUNERAL WITH CREMATION* **\$5,550**

This package includes our basic services and overhead, embalming, dressing, placement in casket, facilities and staff for visitation, facilities, equipment and staff for funeral service, transfer of remains from place of death and cremation process.

(Chapel Oak Rental Casket Included)

TRADITIONAL CHURCH FUNERAL WITH CREMATION* **\$6,085**

This package includes our basic services and overhead, embalming, dressing, placement in casket, facilities and staff for visitation, equipment and staff for funeral in other facility, transfer of remains from place of death, traditional hearse and cremation process.

(Chapel Oak Rental Casket and Traditional Hearse Included)

GRAVESIDE FUNERAL WITH VIEWING AT FUNERAL HOME* **\$4,400**

This package includes our basic services and overhead, embalming, dressing, placement in casket, facilities and staff for visitation, equipment and staff for graveside funeral, transfer of remains from place of death and traditional hearse. (casket, outer burial container and cemetery charges not included)

GRAVESIDE FUNERAL WITH NO VIEWING* **\$4,045**

This package includes our basic services and overhead, washing and disinfecting, up to 3 days refrigeration, dressing, placement in casket, equipment and staff for graveside funeral, transfer of remains from place of death and traditional hearse. (casket, outer burial container and cemetery charges not included)

ITEMIZED PRICE LIST

BASIC SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF AND OVERHEAD.....\$1,765

This basic charge includes 24 hour availability of staff and equipment, securing and recording vital statistics, obtaining authorizations and permits to comply to all state and federal mortuary regulations and arrangement conference with family or responsible party. Also included in this charge are overhead expenses relative to our facility such as insurance, property taxes, maintenance and utility expenses, secretarial and administrative costs. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.)

USE OF STAFF, FACILITIES AND EQUIPMENT

1. Embalming and sanitary care of remains \$555
Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

PRE-PLANNING

Many families find peace of mind in pre-planning their final arrangements. In pre-planning, there are several things to consider. The first step in the process is simply to identify exactly what your final wishes are and then make those wishes known. At Canby and Molalla Funeral Chapels, we can create a pre-arrangement file for you and there is no charge for this service.

The next step is to pre-pay for those services. This is optional and can be handled at the funeral service establishment of your choice. In Oregon, all funeral service providers are required to place pre-paid funds into a funeral “life insurance policy” or a funeral trust account where they reside until time of death.

ALTERNATIVE SERVICES

FORWARDING REMAINS TO ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME*

This charge includes basic services and overhead, securing necessary permits and authorizations, removal of remains from place of death, embalming or refrigeration if requested and local transportation to common carrier. This charge does not include viewing, dressing, a ceremony of any type, a casket or shipping container, shipping charges, special care of autopsied remains or other items that may be requested.

Forwarding remains with no dressing or viewing locally*.....\$2,225

RECEIVING REMAINS FROM ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME

This charge includes basic services and overhead, receiving remains from common carrier and local transportation to place of final disposition (within a 25 mile radius). This charge does not include dressing, viewing or a ceremony of any type. Casket, outer burial container and cemetery charges not included

Receiving remains with burial only (no public or private services).....\$1,995

DIRECT CREMATIONS * (\$1,735)

Our charge for direct cremation (without ceremony) includes: basic services of funeral director and staff, overhead, securing necessary permits and authorizations, removal of remains from place of death and cremation. If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are made of corrugated cardboard.

IMMEDIATE BURIALS * (\$3,045 to \$7,520)

NOTE: An "Immediate Burial" is when our driver transports the body to the grave at a time mutually agreed upon by our staff and the cemetery without the involvement of family. An Immediate Burial is not a Graveside Service and no family is present. If the family wishes to be present, only to witness the burial from a distance, they must add the "Scheduled Delivery of Immediate Burial" charge from the General Price List. If family, friends or clergy wish to be present at the grave (perhaps to say a few words or have a prayer) it is no longer an Immediate Burial and has now become a Graveside Service and will be charged accordingly.

Our charge for immediate burial (without ceremony) includes: basic services of funeral director and staff, overhead, securing necessary permits and authorizations, removal of remains from place of death, care of remains until burial is completed (three days refrigeration included), transportation to cemetery. Immediate burials are scheduled at the convenience of the funeral establishment and the cemetery. The family is not present.

Aquamation (Alkaline Hydrolysis) and Terramation (Natural Organic Reduction)

This charge includes the basic overhead and necessary fees to carry out the local transfer of the deceased to the funeral home, temporary shelter of remains, filing the death certificate and obtaining a disposition permit. It includes consultation with the family, hydrolysis or terramation charges and the return of the processed remains to the funeral home. An outer enclosure is not required. An urn selection will be requested for final disposition or memorialization purposes.
