Ground Burial

Many families choose to inter their loved ones cremated remains in a cemetery lot. Most cemeteries have in-ground sections dedicated solely to cremated remains. However, many families choose a full size grave space in order to inter two sets of cremated remains and to allow for a standard size memorial or companion memorial commemorating their loved one's life. Most cemeteries will require the use of an outer burial container for in-ground burials.



Home

Some families find great solace in having their loved ones nearby. Today, many manufacturers offer urns that are functional but artistic in design so as to complement your home's decor. It's not uncommon for some spouses who have been together for many years to desire having their cremated remains combined into one urn. In those cases, family members will take an urn home for safe-keeping until the surviving spouse dies and the couple can be united together again.



Above Ground Placement

For families who don't like the idea of burying their loved ones urn in the ground, but would like to have the urn in a safe and secure location for family members to visit, above ground placement may be most appropriate. Most cemeteries, and some churches, offer community niches where urns can be placed. However, there is an abundance of other options too, from private cremation estates to cremation benches to statuary placements.



Scattering

For those families who elect to scatter the cremated remains of their loved ones, there are a variety of urns available to make the process easy and dignified for all. Scattering can be done on your own privately owned property, but careful consideration should be given as you may not always own that piece of property. You can also scatter cremated remains in a garden or lake located within a cemetery. The EPA does require that cremated remains be scattered a minimum of three nautical miles off shore in an open body of water.

The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

BASIC SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF— \$3,555

Our fee for the basic services of funeral director and staff includes, but is not limited to, staff to respond to initial request for service; shelter of remains; arrangement conference with family and responsible parties; arrangement of funeral; preparation and filing of necessary authorizations and permits; recording vital statistics; preparation and placement of obituary notice; and coordination with those providing other portions of the funeral, e.g., cemetery, crematory, vault companies and others as required. Also included in this charge are overhead expenses, parking lot and grounds maintenance, taxes, equipment, furnishings, inventory costs, record-keeping, and secretarial and administrative expenses. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains).

PREPARATION OF THE REMAINS:

Embalming \$1,085

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

FORWARDING REMAINS TO ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME- \$5,625

This charge includes the removal of the remains, basic services of staff, embalming, minimum shipping container, necessary authorizations, and local transportation to the airport. This charge does not include visitations, rites, or ceremonies prior to forwarding of the body.

RECEIVING REMAINS FROM ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME- \$4,115

This charge includes temporary shelter of casketed remains, basic services of staff and transportation of remains to the cemetery or crematory. This charge does not include visitation, rites or ceremonies.

IMMEDIATE BURIAL- \$7,080 DOWN TO \$5,870

Our charge for immediate burial includes removal, refrigeration of remains, alternate care of deceased, local transportation to the cemetery, basic services of staff and necessary authorizations. This charge does not include the use of facilities and staff for any visitation or ceremony, public or private, prior to burial. The burial will be scheduled at the mutual convenience of the funeral home and cemetery, with no family or friends present.

DIRECT CREMATION- \$4,140 DOWN TO \$3,960

The charge for a direct cremation includes removal of remains, use of refrigeration facilities, local transportation to crematory, crematory fee for traditional flame cremation, necessary authorizations, courier car and basic services of staff. This charge does not include the use of the facilities and staff for any visitation or ceremony, public or private, prior to the cremation. If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container.

ANATOMICAL DONATION (BODY DONATION)- \$5,730

This charge includes removal of remains, basic service of staff, arterial embalming, necessary authorizations, and long distance transportation to the Anatomical Board. This charge does not include visitations, rites or ceremonies prior to forwarding of the body.
