Basic service charge includes, but is not limited to, staff to respond to initial request for services, arrangement conference with family and/or responsible party, preparation and filing of all necessary certificates and permits, notification to Social Security, placement of Obituary and/or notices in newspaper.

This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials and forwarding or receiving remains.)

Embalming Except in special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial. Direct cremation \$1680 to \$1695

Our charge for a direct cremation (without ceremony) includes basic services of funeral director and staff, a proportionate share of overhead costs, transfer of remains to funeral home (within 25-mile radius), refrigeration, transportation to crematory, necessary authorizations and cremation fee.

If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are a soft cloth pouch or cardboard cremation container.

Forwarding of remains to another funeral home
