Prices effective November 8, 2023 and are subject to change.

The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our Basic Services of the Funeral Director and Staff. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

This list does not include prices for certain items that you may ask us to buy for you, such as newspaper notices, minister honorariums, cemetery fees and flowers. The prices for those items will be show on the Statement of Funeral Goods and Services selected. We charge you for our services in buying these items.

ITEMIZED SELECTIONS

PROFESSIONAL SERVICES..... \$ 2,755.

Basic Services of the Funeral Director & Staff

This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. This fee is already included in our charges for Direct Cremation, Immediate Burial, Forwarding of Remains to Another Funeral Home and/or Receiving Remains from Another Funeral Home. This charge includes, but is not limited to, availability of staff 24 hours a day (365 days a year), staff and facilities to respond to the initial request for services, consultation with responsible party to determine services desired, coordinating service plans with cemetery, crematory and/or other parties involved in the final disposition of the deceased, filing death certificates, obtaining permits with the Health Department, providing assistance in filing social security notification and/or veteran's forms. This also covers facility maintenance, equipment, inventory costs, liability insurance and governmental compliance costs.

Embalming..... \$ 680.

Except in certain, special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as Direct Cremation or Immediate Burial.

Sanitary Care (washing and disinfection of un-embalmed remains – if requested)..... \$ 265.
Refrigeration (after 24 hours and required if deceased is not embalmed – 5 day period) \$ 420.
Refrigeration (per day after initial 5 day period) \$ 80.
Dressing, Casketing and Cosmetizing (of the deceased) \$ 265.
Autopsy or Organ Donation Repair \$ 310.

Facility Rental (when burial or cremation are provided by another funeral home) \$ 1,350.
Includes reduced Basic Services of Funeral Director & Staff, use of Mausoleum Chapel for service, gathering, viewing or reception for up to 4 hours, and staff for service or gathering.

Transportation

Transfer of deceased from place of death to the funeral home (within 30 mile radius) \$ 750.
Transfer of deceased to and from autopsy facility or other facility (within 30 mile radius)..... \$ 365.
Additional Mileage (per loaded mile)..... \$ 4.
Funeral Vehicle (within 30 mile radius) \$ 415.
Service Vehicle (within 30 mile radius)..... \$ 185.

Direct Cremation (without services or ceremony) – **starting at \$1,215 up to**.....\$17,840.

If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are cardboard. Other cremation caskets are available. A complete price list will be provided at the funeral home.

Our charge for direct cremation include: basic services for funeral director and staff, transportation of deceased to the funeral home (within 30 mile radius), refrigeration (up to 5 days), consultation with responsible party to determine services desired, clerical & administrative services, filing of the death certificate & necessary permits, assistance with forms for social security and/or veteran’s benefits, on-line obituary and the actual cremation process of the body.

Direct Cremation with container provided by purchaser \$ 1,215.

Direct Cremation with minimum cardboard cremation container \$ 1,330.

Direct Cremation with casket from our selection (in addition to the cost of the casket) \$ 1,215.

Immediate Burial (without visitation, services or ceremony) – **starting at \$1,550 up to**.....\$30,965.

Our charge for direct burial include: basic services of funeral director and staff, transportation of deceased to the funeral home (within 30 mile radius), refrigeration (up to 5 days), consultation with responsible party to determine services desired, clerical & administrative services, filing of the death certificate & necessary permits, assistance with forms for social security and/or veteran’s benefits, on-line obituary and transportation of the casket by service van to any local cemetery within 30 miles of our facility.

Immediate Burial with casket provided by purchaser..... \$ 1,550.

Immediate Burial with minimum casket \$ 2,385.

Immediate Burial with casket from our casket selection (in addition to the cost of the casket)..... \$ 1,550.

Forwarding of Remains to Another Funeral Home..... \$ 2,485.

Our charge for forwarding of remains to another funeral home include: basic services of funeral director and staff, transportation of deceased to the funeral home (within 30 mile radius), embalming or other preparation of the deceased, dressing & casketing of the deceased, transportation of the casket by service vehicle to local airport, consultation with responsible party to coordinate arrangements with receiving funeral home, clerical & administrative services, filing of the death certificate & necessary permits, assistance with forms for social security and/or veteran’s benefits and on-line obituary. (This does not include casket selection, air tray or combo shipping tray, state filing fee, certified copies of the death certificate or the actual air freight charges by the airlines.

Receiving Remains from Another Funeral Home..... \$ 1,860.

Our charge for receiving remains from another funeral home include: basic services of funeral director and staff, coordinating the details with the other funeral home and cemetery involved, on-line obituary, transportation by service vehicle of casket from airport to our facility or directly to cemetery as requested and temporary housing of the deceased at our facility. (This does not include cemetery charges, air freight charges, viewing of the deceased or funeral ceremonies.)
