General Price List - Effective July 10, 2024

The goods and services shown below are those we can provide for our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

PROFESSIONAL SERVICES:

Basic services of Funeral Director and Staff and Overhead \$3,285.00

Our services include: conducting the arrangement conference, planning the funeral; consulting with family and clergy; shelter of remains; preparing and filing of necessary notices; obtaining necessary authorizations and permits; coordinating with the cemetery, crematory, or other third parties. In addition, this fee includes a proportionate share of our basic overhead costs.

This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.)

Embalming \$595.00

Except in certain special cases, the law does not require embalming. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want to embalm, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial or when refrigeration or use of dry ice is available.

This includes washing and disinfection, dressing, cosmetology, and casketing of the body.

This includes necessary washing and disinfection, and preparation of the body for viewing on a dressing table, in a casket, or in an alternative container.

AUTOMOTIVE EQUIPMENT:

Transfer of Remains to Funeral Home from Place of Death (within five-county Metropolitan Area)..... \$675.00
Beyond this radius, we charge \$2.95 per mile one way. An additional \$100.00 fee will be charged for the transfer of remains from a private residence or when a ceremony is held during the time of the transfer.
Transfer of Remains to Crematory from the Funeral Home \$295.00
Hearse (within five County Metropolitan Area) \$580.00
Beyond this radius, we charge \$2.95 per mile one way.

SPECIAL SERVICES:

Forwarding of Remains to Another Funeral Home..... \$2,320.00
Our charge includes basic services of the funeral director and staff, a proportionate share of overhead costs, removal of remains, embalming and other preparation of remains, and local transportation from the place of death and to the transport terminal.
Receiving of Remains from Another Funeral Home \$1,665.00
Our charge includes basic services of the funeral director and staff, a proportionate share of overhead costs, transportation of remains to the funeral home and to the place of final disposition.
Direct Cremation \$3,460.00 to \$19,015.00
Our packaged charge for direct cremation (without ceremony) includes basic services of funeral director and staff, a proportionate share of overhead costs, removal of remains, private family viewing, participation in the cremation process, transportation to crematory, necessary authorizations, minimum cremation container, a basic cremation urn, medical examiner fees, and the crematory fee. Complete itemization before the package price is available upon request.
Federal Trade Commission Disclosure: If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are corrugated fiberboard and hardboard.
Minnesota Disclosure: Minnesota law does not require you to purchase a casket for cremation. If you want to arrange a cremation, you can use a cremation container. A cremation container is a combustible, closed container that encases the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or corrugated cardboard and into which a dead human body is placed prior to insertion into a cremation chamber for cremation. The containers we provide are corrugated fiberboard and hardboard.

Outer Burial Container \$1,150.00 to \$24,120.00
In most areas of the country, state or local law does not require that you buy a container to surround the casket in the grave. However, many cemeteries require that you have such a container so that the grave will not sink in. Either a grave liner or a burial vault will satisfy these requirements.
